

WHA Street Representatives

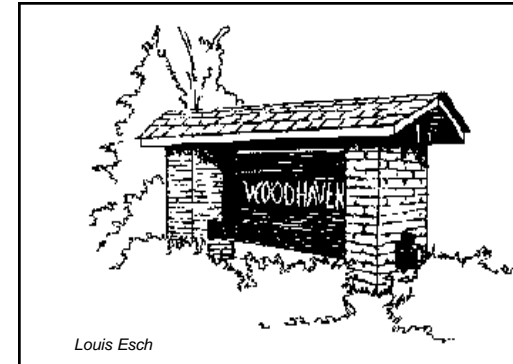

Fall 2009 - Loose-Leaf Pick-Up

The Town Highway Department will begin loose-leaf pick-up on October 19. The schedule of pick-up locations will be posted on the Highway Department page of the website but the weather can force changes - call the Highway Department at 382-1406.

Loose leaves must be placed on the edge of your lawn. Brush and bagged leaves must be placed separately from loose leaves; the vacuum machine cannot pick up leaves with objects mixed in.

...On water and sewers

Do you water your lawn? If so you've likely seen a hefty water bill. This is because the water used on your lawn is charged as though it is going through the sewer. By having a second water meter, if your home has an irrigation system or if you water with hoses, you will only pay for water that is truly going into the sewer – not the water that is going into your yard.



We can petition the Town for the right to have a second water meter but we need at least 50 signatures. Please contact David Hennel at David@Hennel.net if you would like to show your support and sign this petition. **When we join together, we can make a difference.**

Woodcrest Sewer System - The project is well underway. Collector line boring and installation of the pipe parallel to the roadway has been completed on the north side of the road and the affected residents are currently having their laterals and grinder pumps installed. Nineteen residents are affected (Mostly on the upper block of Woodcrest Drive). The project is expected to be completed by Oct. 16, 2009.

Woodhaven Street Paving - The following streets have been capped with one and one half inches (1 1/2") of paving: All of Governor, Oakwood, Elmwood, and Glenhill Drives. In addition, portions of the following streets were also capped: Mountainwood and Woodhaven Drive. This was completed in the months of July and August. Completion of the capping operation is expected after the completion of the Woodcrest sewer Project. Thanks to Richard Leclair and the town council for funding this long overdue project.

Deed Restrictions

Virtually all homes listed in the old "Woodhaven" neighborhood are on land originally deeded to the "Woodhaven Land Development Corporation" with certain use restrictions that continue in force as the homes are sold to subsequent owners. (The original deed on your property may be seen at the County Clerk's office. A copy may be attached to your mortgage papers.) Among these restrictions are:

- No outside parking or storing of trailers, campers, boats, etc. except on pavement;
- No outbuildings or unattached structures.
